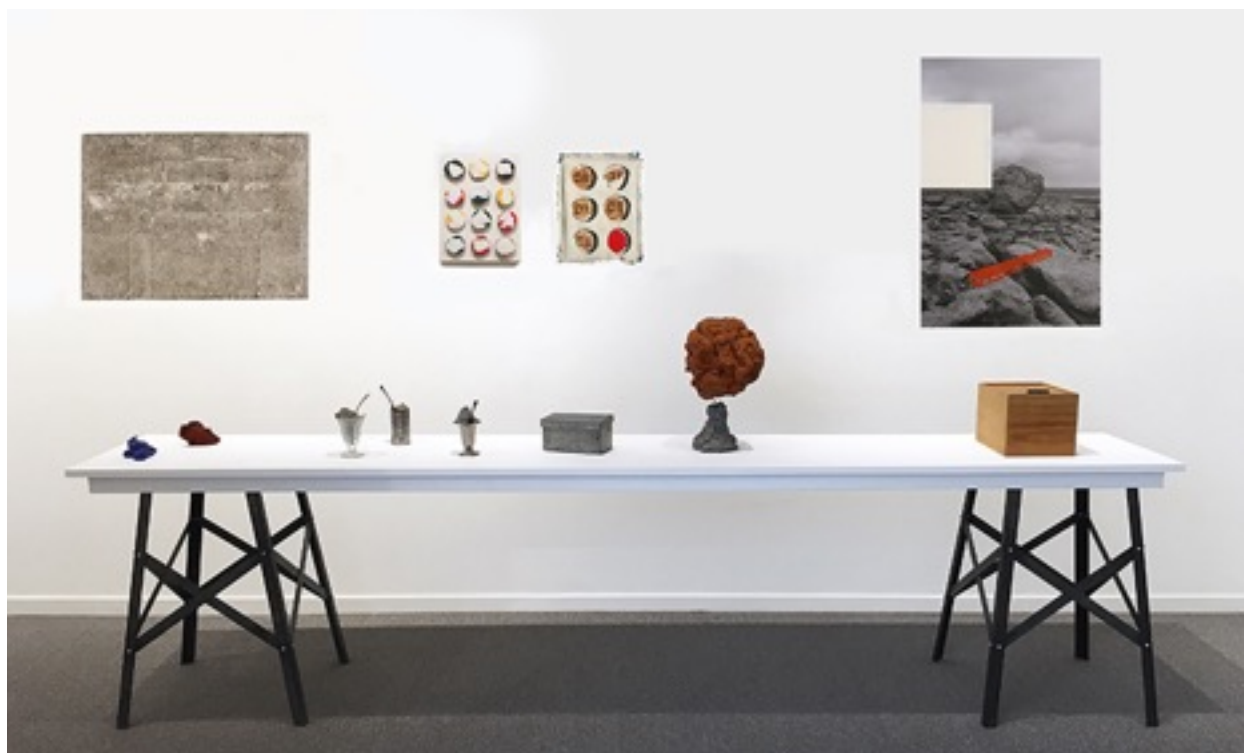

Anglim Gilbert Gallery is pleased to announce a presentation of works by West Coast artist **David Ireland** (1930 - 2009) at Frieze New York.

A prominent member of the Bay Area conceptual artists, Ireland brought together elements of performance, architecture and Zen practice. He lived by a philosophy of discovery -- the sense that artistic creativity was the re-invention of materials and forms already in existence.

Ireland gained attention for his transformation of a 1886 Victorian house in San Francisco's Mission District in 1975, renovating the wooden structure and creating a hybrid artwork. Fixtures, furniture and debris from his daily performative practice were documented and turned into paintings, sculptures and recorded actions. After Ireland's death the house has undergone a thorough restoration and re-opened to the public in January of this year. The San Francisco Art Institute presented a retrospective exhibition with a catalogue, "David Ireland", in tandem with the opening of the house. A book by Constance Lewallen, *500 Capp Street, David Ireland's House* (2015, UC Press) was published early last year.

Anglim Gilbert Gallery's presentation at Frieze New York's Spotlight section will include David Ireland's sculptural objects, drawings and paintings made from earth, cement, wood and painted photographs.
